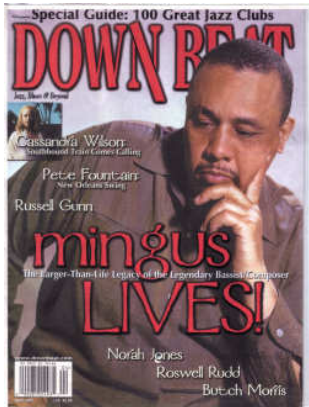




Nighttown Named One of the World's Great Jazz Clubs Says Downbeat Magazine
